## Instructions to Authors

### Submission Guidelines

Abstracts should clearly state the following: paper title; presenting author's name and full contacts details; conference topic to which the subject is most closely related. In order to make the abstract as informative possible, you should include the purpose of the study, the method used, the result observed, and the conclusions based upon the results. You may subtitle the paragraphs in bold format in the following order: Background, Method, Results, and Conclusion. Use maximum 2500 characters for your abstract.

### Receipt of Submission

Acknowledgement of the receipt of your submission will be returned to your email address upon submission. If you do not receive the confirmation email, your abstract needs to be re-submitted.

### Notification of Acceptance

Notification of acceptance/rejection will be e-mailed to the corresponding author. The presenting author must register for the Congress and pay the registration fee before 31 July, 2007. Accepted abstracts will be published in the Abstract Book.
